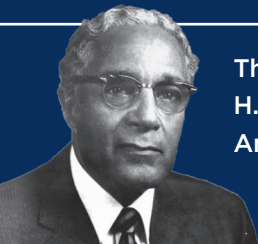
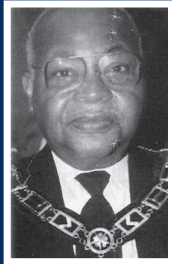




Silas A. Butler, Jr. earned a Bachelor Degree from Virginia Union University in the early 60s. He was a charter member of Kappa Epsilon Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. in Prince George's County. Butler became a Master Mason at Cartwright Lodge #129 in 1979. In 1990, He was one of charter members of Charles H. Wesley Lodge #147 located in Bowie MD. He also served as the first Worshipful Master from July 1990 until June 1991.



The Lodge name sake Charles H. Wesley was the 3rd African American to receive a PhD degree from Harvard University. Prince Hall Masonry is the oldest

African American institution in the United States, starting in 1775. Prince Hall Masonry in Maryland was established on September 12, 1876.

Our Lodge was chartered on July 1, 1990 and at that time meetings were held on the campus of Bowie State University.
